

PCC-USA Elections for year 2012 term of office

Notes & Instructions for Nomination Form

PCC-USA Officers are elected annually for a one (1) year term for the following nine (9) positions:

- 1- President-Elect
- 2- Senior Vice president
- 3- Vice President – Administration
- 4- Vice president – Liaison
- 5- Vice President – Marketing
- 6- Vice President – Media Relations
- 7- General Secretary
- 8- Joint Secretary
- 9- Director Finance

Pertinent information as well as the qualifications and requirements for various positions are briefly listed below. These are for reference purposes only and by no means are complete or exhaustive. The actual PCC-USA Constitution & Bylaws (“PCC-USA C & B”) shall prevail in all instances arising from any omission or mistake.

You may nominate only one (1) individual for any one position. *Nominations and/or seconding of multiple individuals for same position by the same nominator or same seconding member may render invalid all such nominations.* You may however submit nominations for several different positions for different individuals. Please make copies of the Nomination Form as needed.

Both the nominator and the person seconding the nomination must be dues paying members of PCC-USA in good standing as per the Membership List at the time of nomination, or be members of the Advisory Council. Please consult the membership list(s) for status verification purposes or contact the PCC-USA officials.

For all positions, except as noted below, the nominee must be a dues paying non-corporate member of PCC-USA in good standing for at least sixty (60) days prior to the General Election day; be over 18 years of age by election day; and must be a citizen or lawful permanent resident of USA.

Additionally, for the position of President-Elect only, the nominee must also be of Pakistani lineage.

A nomination fee of US \$100.00 required with all nominations; **ONLY** Cash or Money Order.

Eligibility to vote at the general elections will be based on the “record date” set by EBD; which is 10 December 2011 for these elections. Only those individuals who are dues paying members by the “record date” will be allowed to vote in General Elections.
